**GDOL Releases PUA 1099 Tax Forms**

**Hagåtña, Guam** – Pandemic unemployment tax forms are now available from the Guam Department of Labor for claimants to download and print from their hireguam.com dashboards. The 1099s are also currently being printed and will be mailed out by the due date of Jan. 31.

Unemployment benefits are taxable and must be declared when you file your 2020 tax returns. Keep your 1099s and include them with your paperwork when you file.

“Unemployment compensation is considered income and therefore is taxable. About 80 to 90% of the 2020 applicants opted to have federal withholdings automatically taken out of their weekly payments. Some may see a bit of a return depending on their tax bracket. For those who did not opt to have the taxes withheld, please make sure you set some money aside to make your payments whenever you file,” said Department of Labor Director David Dell’Isola.
